¹ From the DESE website: Early college high schools (ECHS) are a proven model for preparing students, especially low-income, minority, and first-generation college-goers, for postsecondary education. They provide students with a college experience and an opportunity to get a head start on earning college credits while still in high school. Given the state's need for highly skilled workers in STEM areas, Districts have been encouraged to consider developing ECHS that motivate and prepare students to explore STEM career pathways while still enrolled in high school and to pursue STEM majors in college. ECHS are designed to result in higher rates of college going for students currently underrepresented in higher education and to build an accelerated route linking secondary education with postsecondary educational opportunities. These schools are developed through agreements between high schools and postsecondary institutions.
